## Team Scoring & Awards

The state meets will be a timed finals format over two days. Team scoring will be for the first 16 places: 1<sup>st</sup> place = 20 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup>=17, 3<sup>rd</sup>=16, 4<sup>th</sup>=15, 5<sup>th</sup>=14, 6<sup>th</sup>=13, 7<sup>th</sup>=12, 8<sup>th</sup>=11, 9<sup>th</sup>=9, 10<sup>th</sup>=7, 11<sup>th</sup>=6, 12<sup>th</sup>=5, 13<sup>th</sup>=4, 14<sup>th</sup>=3, 15<sup>th</sup>=2, 16<sup>th</sup>=1. Medals will be presented to the **first six places in the individual events** and the **first three places in the relay events**. Team trophies will be awarded to the first and second place winners. No hats or head coverings may be worn during awards ceremonies. Swimmers are allowed to wear their team sweat suits on the podium for the medals presentation and awards event photo.

## Limited Parking & Spectator Seating

Public parking will be free in the lot west of the practice football field which is west of the Richards PE Building. BYU is in session on Friday so make sure to adhere to all parking restrictions. Cars and buses will be ticketed or impounded if parked illegally.

**Prices for admission are \$6.00 for adults and \$4.00 for students per session.** Because of limited seating, tickets will only be sold prior to each session at the meet site. There will be no advance ticket sales and no reserved seats sold. Seating is on a first come, first serve basis. Patrons are not allowed to save seats. The facility will be cleared after each session. A separate ticket must be purchased for each classification session. Only ticketed patrons will be allowed admission to the balcony for seating.

**Spectators should arrive early because seating is extremely limited (only about 1100 seats available).** Once the balcony is full, the Utah Fire Code prevents us from seating any additional spectators. In the case of a sell-out, arrangements have been made for patrons to view a LIVE VIDEO FEED for free in Room 267. With a sell-out, patrons will be given a number that will be called in sequence when seats become available.



## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR COACHES

### Qualifying for the State Meet

The region championship meet is the last chance to submit state qualifying times. The top two swimmers in each individual event at the region meet will automatically qualify for the state meet. The remaining qualifiers will be based on the best verifiable times from qualifying or region meets to a total of 24 swimmers per individual event. The top relay in each relay event at region meet will automatically qualify for the state meet. The remaining qualifiers will be based on the best verifiable times from the top 50 list or the region meet to a total of 16 relays.

### Process for Submitting State Entries to the State Meet Director (Revised 1-16-12)

State entries must be submitted electronically on the HY-TEK program and then emailed to the State Meet Director, Dan Miller at [mild754@gmail.com](mailto:mild754@gmail.com) by **3:00 pm the Friday prior to the state meet (Jan. 27, 3A & 4A and Feb. 3, 5A)**. The email to Dan Miller should include the HY-TEK file, which includes entries for individual and relay events (team only, no individual names for relay entries) and the three (3) individuals that will receive the coaches' deck passes. Schools only get 3 coaches' passes. Call Dan Miller (801-360-7098) if you have any questions on the state entries.

- **Dan Miller will email the unofficial meet and roster to coaches on Sunday for their review.**
- When coaches receive the unofficial meet they should carefully review the swimmers that qualified in the individual events and then immediately email Dan the name of any person that is not on the roster and is a member of the relay team that will swim at the state meet, **along with the names of the four non-individually qualified relay alternates** that each school receives (TOTAL of four, any combo of girls or boys, regardless of the number of relay events).
- Email any additions or changes ASAP after reviewing the preliminary meet, but no later than Sunday evening (6:00 pm) so the final meet can be created.
- After corrections are made the **official meet will be emailed to coaches by the Monday prior to State.**
- One alternate is allowed on individual events. There will not be any alternate relay teams (i.e., 17, 18).
- All athletes who qualify through the region meet must participate in the state meet as per the NFHS Swim Rules Book. If a swimmer will not be present at State, he or she must be scratched at the conclusion of the region meet and **before the results are turned in** at the seeding meeting. ***Emergency scratches will be accepted at the coaches meeting.***

### Pickup Team Packets with Deck Passes

A team packet, containing the deck passes, will be available for pickup from the UHSAA office (199 E. 7200 So. Midvale) after 1:00 pm the Wednesday preceding the meet or at the state meet site on Friday where admission tickets are sold (by balcony entrance). Passes will be issued only to those who qualify for State Participants must have passes with them at all times other than when swimming. Random checks may be made.

### Passes Required for Admission to the Deck

On the first day, teams SHALL NOT ENTER THE DECK ANY EARLIER than 60 minutes prior to the general warm-up. On the second day, teams SHALL NOT ENTER THE DECK ANY EARLIER than 30 minutes prior to the general warm-up. Admittance to the deck requires a deck pass and picture I.D. for everyone. BYU ushers will be seated by the locker rooms and will ask to see a deck pass and photo I.D. (i.e. driver's license, activity card) when entering the deck area. Deck passes will be generated from the state qualifying list. Schools get (3) deck passes for coaches or managers.

### Bus Drop-Off & Team Pick-up

BUSES UNLOAD at the Richards P.E. Building NORTHWEST DOORS and then PARK IN LOT WEST OF LAVELL EDWARDS FOOTBALL STADIUM. Coaches should call the bus drivers on their cell phones for pickup and be outside waiting when bus arrives. **BUS DRIVERS CANNOT PARK OR WAIT CURBSIDE TO PICKUP TEAMS!**

### State Meet Reminders

- Coaches, please be judicious in ensuring that your swimmers do not abuse our privileges while on the university campus. Do not allow your swimmers to wander the building or grounds unsupervised.
- Balloons are not allowed in any part of the BYU facility. No glass containers will be allowed on deck. Only bottled liquids in plastic containers will be allowed on deck.
- Participants must bring their own towels. Dressing room attendants will patrol the locker areas to help us take good care of the facilities.
- Based on OSHA blood born pathogen regulations, **there will be no head or body shaving allowed in dressing and shower areas.** All shaving must be done prior to arrival at the meet site.
- There are no diving starts allowed in the warm down pool, this pool is for feet first entry only.
