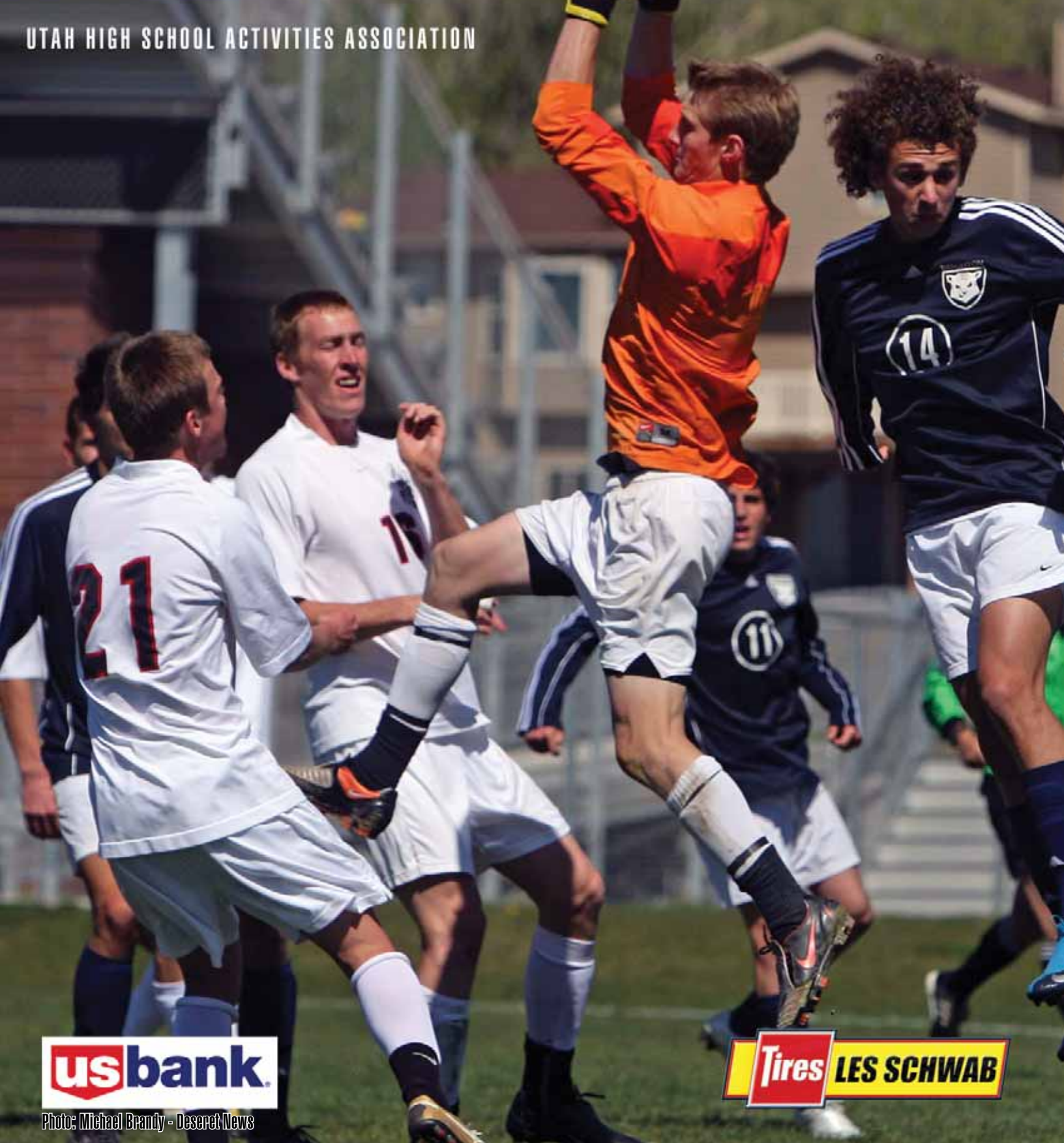

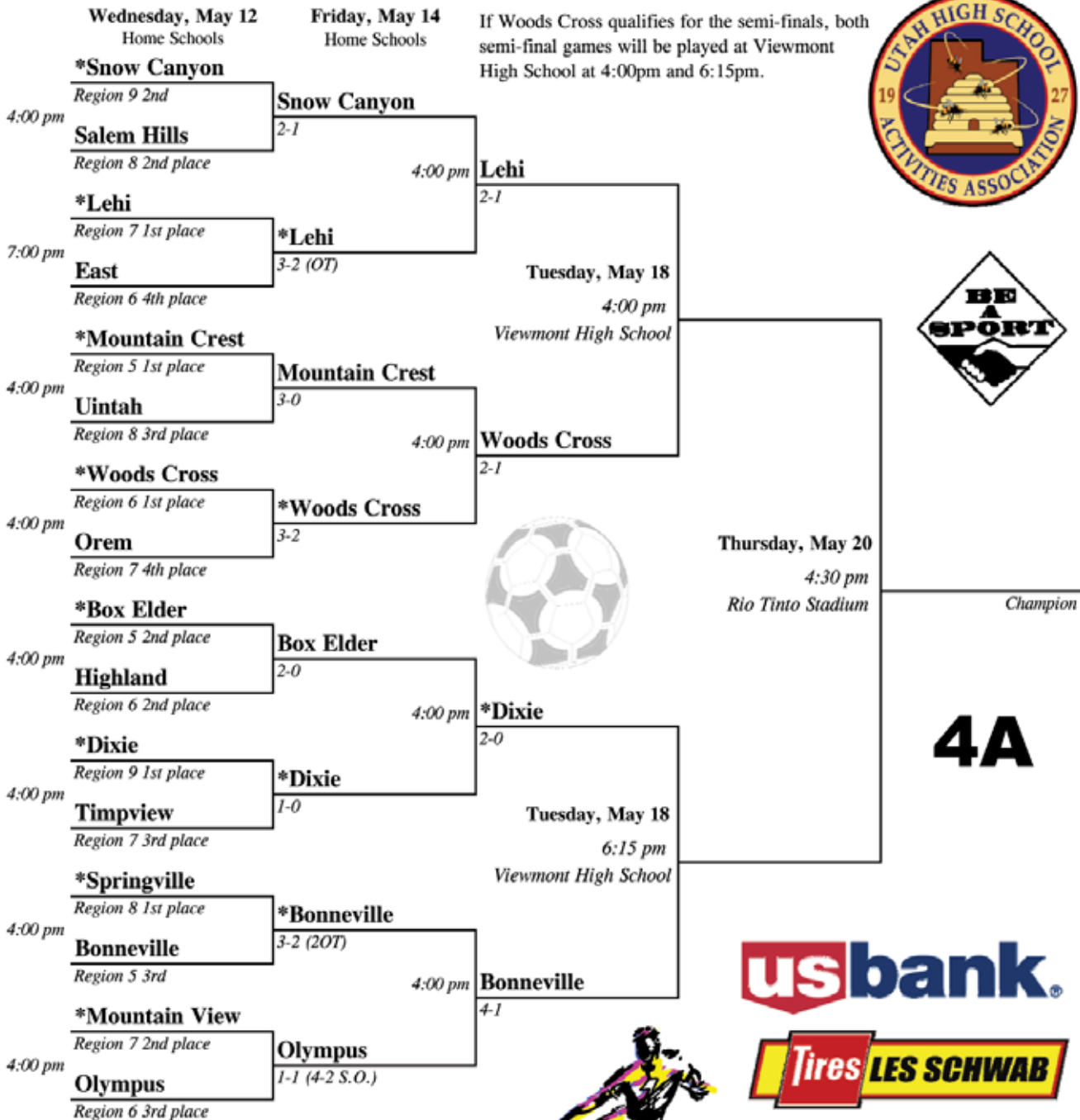

****Note:** Either Region 9 #2 or Region 5 #4 will qualify but not both. For Region 9 #2 to qualify, that school must finish no lower than 3rd place in the Region among all teams both 3A and 4A. If Region 9 #2 places 2nd they will host the first round game; if they place 3rd they will play at Region 8 #2 in the first round. If Region 9 #2 does not qualify (finishes below 3rd place in the Region) then Region 5 #4 will qualify and play Region 8 #1.

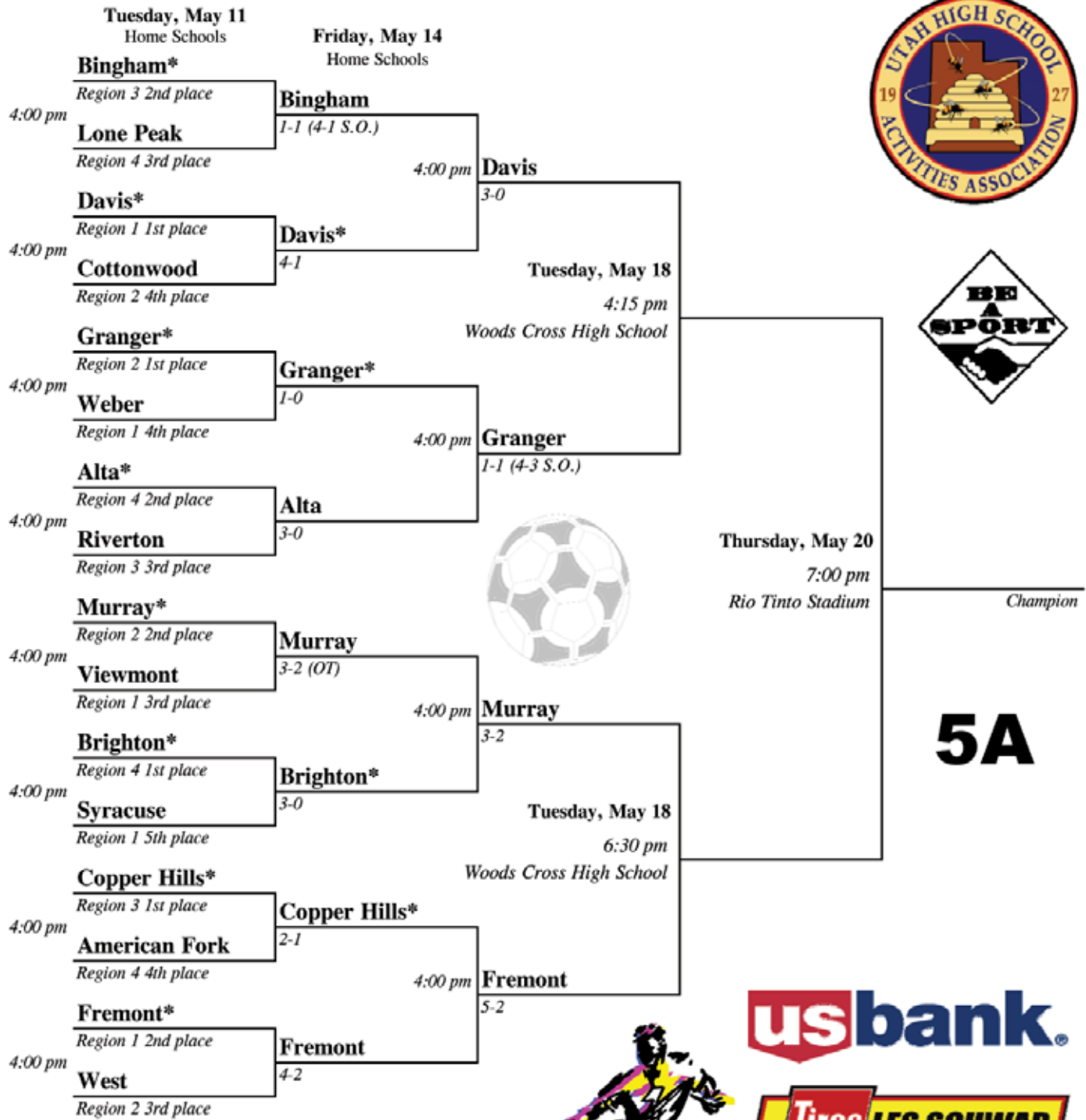

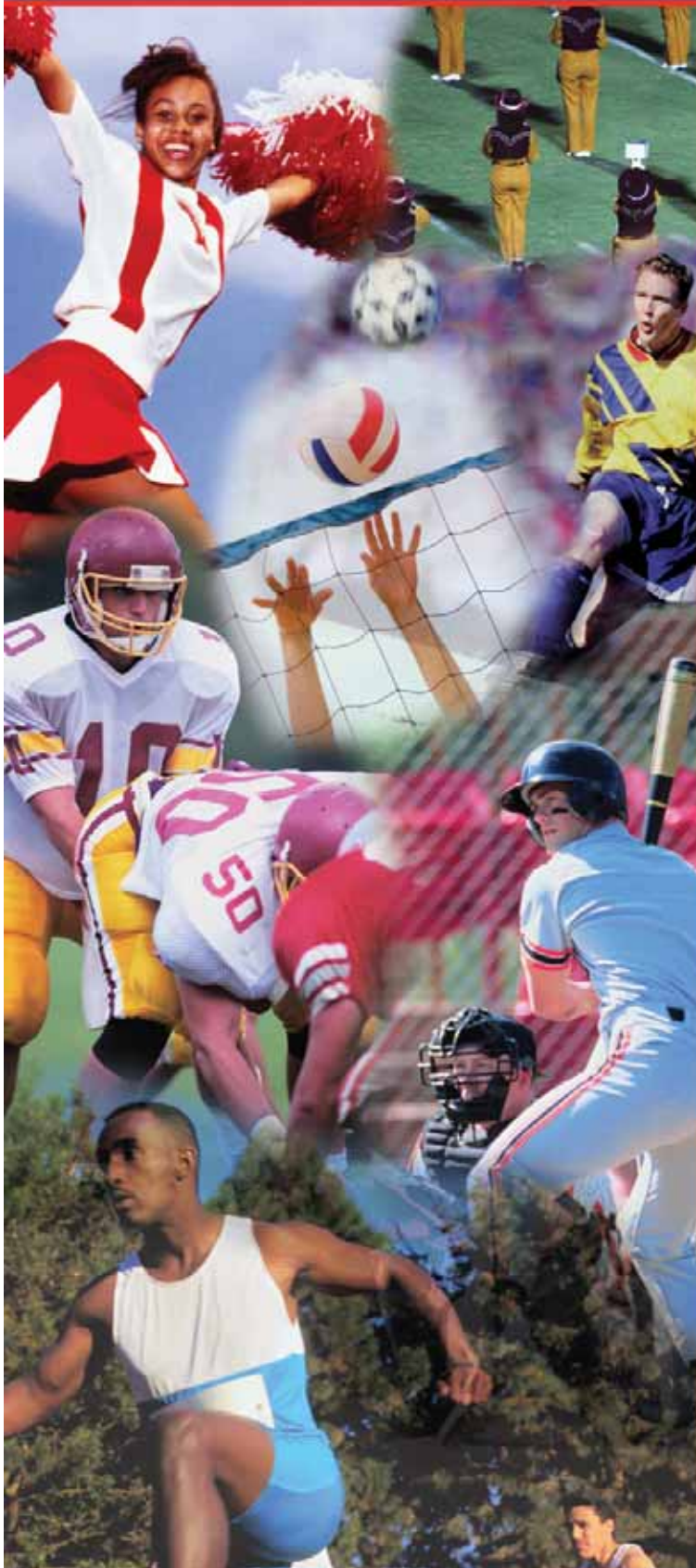

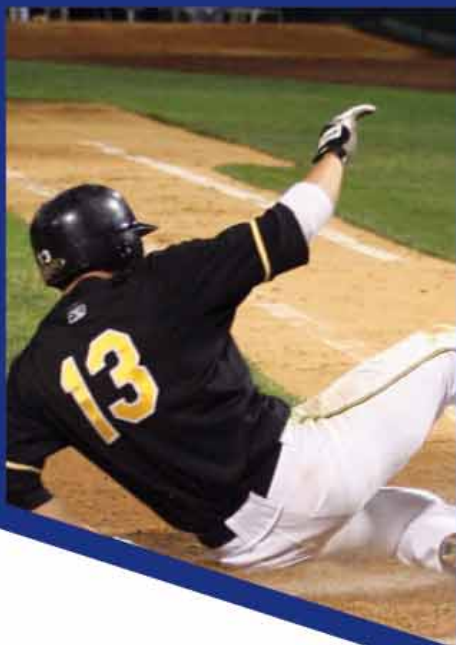
