

Board of Trustees Meeting Summary
March 26, 2026

1. Chairman Luke Rasmussen called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.
2. Ms. Carol Lear provided a USBE report.
3. Mr. Rob Cuff, Executive Director, provided the Committee with a list of winter state champions and a winter financial report.
4. The UHSAA staff reviewed winter activities, which included basketball, cheer, drill team, swim and wrestling.
5. Mr. Jeff Cluff reviewed the winter ejection reports for coaches and players and provided an officiating update. The emphasis on sportsmanship has helped the respect and relationships between coaches and officials improve.
6. Ms. Jan Whittaker discussed the UHSAA sportsmanship initiative. She encouraged all schools and/or regions to increase the awareness of good sportsmanship.
7. Ms. Missy Mackay-Whiteurs reported that the UHSAA Student Leadership Conferences will be held in the fall by region or on a multi-region basis and shared information regarding cheer safety clinics.
8. Ms. Whittaker provided a report on the Women in Sports Day and an Esports update, which will conclude its first championship season in April.
9. Mr. Chris Shipman reported on the Unified Sports Tournament for basketball. The UHSAA and SOUT (Special Olympics Utah) are once again joining together to provide this outstanding experience for student athletes.
10. Mr. Brenan Jackson discussed the 2026 summer moratorium and coaches' certification.
11. The Summer Moratorium is June 29-July 5. Schools may change the summer moratorium dates, but the change must be made as an entire school and submitted to UHSAA.
12. Mr. Cuff and staff discussed the realignment of member schools for the school years 2027-2029. Proposed format and procedures will be reviewed and discussed by the Executive Committee and Board of Trustees in future meetings.
13. The Board of Trustees hosted a luncheon as part of their regular meeting for the 2025-2026 Circle of Fame inductees, Super Fans, Heart of the Arts and Spirit of Sport Award winners.
