TICKET PRICES & SPECTATOR ADMISSION

Spectators can purchase tickets online at <u>www.uhsaa.org</u> or at the UCCU ticket office the day of the event. The UCCU ticket office will open 90 minutes prior to the competition start time. Schools can contact the UHSAA office (801-566-0681) to purchase pre-sale tickets for the competition. Ticket Prices for State Drill Competition: Adults \$8.00, Students (grades K-12) \$5.00, Senior Citizens (65+) \$5.00, Kids 5 and younger are free of charge. Spectators will not be allowed to enter the arena for seating until 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, 8:00 a.m. on Friday and 7:00 a.m. on Saturday. **Saving seats is not allowed**. Blankets or other items shall not be used to save seats.

SATURDAY FINALS SEATING INFORMATION- PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ARENA WILL BE CLEARED FOLLOWING THE 2A-3A-4A FINALS. A SEPARATE TICKET MUST BE PURCHASED FOR THE 5A/6A FINALS. ENTRY INTO THE ARENA FOR THE 5A AND 6A FINALS WILL BEGIN AT 4:00 PM. IF SPECTATORS PLAN TO SHOW UP EARLY TO PURCHASE TICKETS AND STAND IN LINE, <u>BE PREPARED TO STAND OUTSIDE!!!!! THERE WILL BE NO FORMING</u> <u>OF LINES INSIDE OF THE UCCU CENTER.</u>

TEAM DROP-OFF, CHECK-IN & ARENA SEATING

Coaches shall provide their driver with the map of the drop-off route posted on the Drill page at <u>www.uhsaa.org</u>. **Buses must follow the designated route through the UVU parking lot to the team drop-off area** by the entrance to the North Back Service Lot <u>(see map)</u>. **TEAMS SHALL WALK DOWN THE RAMP ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE UCCU CENTER AND CHECK-IN AT THE NORTH ENTRANCE** (the large garage door on the north side). Please come prepared knowing the number of team members you have, as this information is needed for the check-in process. After dropping off the team, buses proceed north out of the parking and follow the designated route as outlined on the map. <u>Buses are not allowed to park anywhere on campus on Thursday or Friday, but can park</u> <u>in Lot L 14 on Saturday</u>. A shuttle will bring the drivers to the UCCU Center. Coaches shall have their teams check-in as a group to have their hands stamped for the day. Teams are allowed to check-in at the following times:

With limited seating for spectators, teams will be seated 3, 9, 10, 11, 12, 17 and 18. Please see the seating map. Participants are asked to have only a small bag with them while in this area. No blankets or large bags allowed. To prevent saving of seats, team members will NOT be allowed to sit or leave items in the spectator seating area prior to the competition starting or during the competition. <u>No saving seats.</u>

TEAM DRESSING AREAS & COSTUME STORAGE

Each team will be provided an area in the **WEST TUNNEL** for costume changes. These are not secure areas, so do not leave possessions unattended. Mirrors and plugs will be limited so please come prepared. Do not leave curling irons on unattended at any time. Remember that this is just a curtain area as well as a walkway, so please dress in the dressing rooms and do not leave any valuables unattended. UVU has asked that we do not plug curling irons into the hallway outlets near their offices. There are two restrooms in the west tunnel and one locker room for use by drill team members. It will be Locker Room 6. This is NOT a team area. This locker room is for restroom purposes only and will be strictly monitored. Any team taking advantage of the use of this locker room may receive a **sportsmanship penalty**. The costume storage area will consist of pipe and drape with chairs inside of the area. Locker rooms will **not** be available for teams. Pods 3 &4, the area to store your bags will not be ready until the teams before you vacate the area. Please be aware of this if you are planning to come early. A general storage area will be provided.

UCCU DOES NOT ALLOW OUTSIDE FOOD

UCCU does not allow outside food in their arena. However, teams will be allowed to bring no more than two coolers to provide nourishment for the athletes. Teams can eat at the concessions level or in an area outside the arena. PLEASE, NO CROCKPOTS!!

UVU TRAINER ON STAFF

A certified UVU trainer will be on staff 30 minutes prior to the start of the competition. The training room is located in the east tunnel on arena floor level. Ice is available if needed for treatment of injuries.

ENTRANCE, EXIT and PERFORMANCE INSTRUCTIONS

The order of performance will be **Military, Dance and Character**. **ALL TEAMS MUST ENTER & EXIT FROM THE NORTH END OF THE FLOOR (NO EXCEPTIONS).** Penalties will be assessed for entering and exiting the floor from the wrong direction. A floor judge will check the following: jewelry, fingernails, etc.

> 1A, 3A & 5A will perform facing EAST; 2A, 4A & 6A will perform facing WEST.

ROTATION FOR TEAMS TO FOLLOW

The rotation of the day will be as follows: teams will go from the dressing area, to the warm-up area (in the balconies at the north end of the arena), to the hall outside the arena, to the performance floor.

Teams are responsible to go to the practice area on their own. Teams must be ready to perform at their designated time or risk receiving a penalty according to UHSAA rules. Members of the UVU Dance Team will assist teams in lining up and moving onto the floor when it is time to perform. It is the responsibility of the coach to have their team in proper place at the proper time so they do not miss their rotation onto the performing floor.

When teams have finished competing for the day, we suggest that you remove all of your belongings from the pipe and curtain dressing area because this will not be a secure area. As soon as the awards ceremony is over, your score sheets will be available at the table on the arena floor. Coaches will receive audio files of judge's comments via e-mail following the semi-final and final performances. No tabulation results will be given until after the final day of competition.

<u>MUSIC</u>

Competition music must be sent in a music file prior to January 28, 2018 to: <u>ssproductionsoffice@gmail.com</u>. Subject line: UHSAA drill 2018 and school name. Files should be named according to school name and category (military, dance, character). In the email put your name, school name, cell phone number and email address. Include the length of each song to ensure that they have been sent in their entirety. Coaches will be able to adjust music tempo the day of the competition. There will be a CD player available as a back-up only. Teams must have a representative at the table to start the music and to notify the sound technician immediately if there are any technical difficulties. Failure to have a representative at the sound table will result in a penalty. There will be three chairs set up on the opposite side of the floor from the sound table for the coaches whose teams are performing WEST to sit and watch their team. These seats are for coaches only. Coaches will be limited to 3 on the floor or behind the sound table.

SPORTSMANSHIP RULE (See Drill Section of the UHSAA Handbook)

Unsportsmanlike conduct by drill team members or coaches <u>during</u> the competition will result in a 2-point penalty per routine judge for each violation. If unsportsmanlike conduct is committed during the competition, a written complaint must be submitted to the competition director within the time frame of the current competition category. Any member of the UHSAA Tournament Committee may assess these points. The points would be deducted before the ranking scores are given and would be assessed to routine category being performed nearest the infraction. A sportsmanship penalty may be assessed to any team who changes costumes inside of the performance arena.

VIDEOTAPING FOR COMMERCIAL USE IS PROHIBITED
