Executive Committee Meeting Summary January 11, 2023

- 1. Chairman Craig Hammer called the meeting to order and reviewed important dates found in the UHSAA Ready Reference Calendar, UHSAA Moratoriums and Academic All-State deadlines (see www.uhsaa.org).
- 2. Mr. Rob Cuff, Executive Director, shared with the Committee a list of fall state champions.
- 3. Mr. Marc Hunter, UIAAA Executive Director, discussed the spring UIAAA Conference which will be held April 12-15 in St. George. He also gave a report on the NIAAA Conference which was held in Nashville, Tennessee, in December.
- 4. The Staff discussed the upcoming state championships and festivals in competitive cheer, drill team, swimming, basketball, wrestling, speech and debate, theatre and music.
- 5. The Executive Committee discussed the Summer Moratorium adjustment for member schools. The dates for the moratorium are June 28-July 4. The application for adjustment must be made as an entire school.
- 6. RegisterMyCoach and coaches' certification were discussed. All member schools must use the system, register their coaches and verify coaches' certification.
- 7. The importance of interested schools signing up for Unified Sports in basketball, soccer and track and field was discussed. Schools need to contact Brenan (soccer) and Jon (Basketball and Track and Field) immediately, if interested, at the UHSAA office.
- 8. It was again stated by the Committee that a basketball shot clock must be used for all post-season contests.
- 9. The Committee discussed a proposal for post-season soccer. The recommendation was to use the directive from the Board of Trustees to create a sub-committee to discuss the soccer proposal among other concerns regarding the alignment of member schools.
- 10. Super Fan Award winners and Circle of Fame inductees were announced and will be honored at upcoming winter state tournaments.
- 11. Mr. Cuff provided the Committee with articles relating to education-based activities.
