- 1. Chairman Craig Hammer called the meeting to order and reviewed important dates found in the UHSAA Ready Reference Calendar, UHSAA Moratoriums and Academic All-State deadlines (see <a href="https://www.uhsaa.org">www.uhsaa.org</a>).
- 2. Mr. Rob Cuff, Executive Director, shared with the Committee a list of fall state champions.
- 3. Mr. Marc Hunter, UIAAA Executive Director, discussed the spring UIAAA Conference which will be held April 17-20 in St. George. He also gave a report on the NIAAA Conference which was held in Orlando, Florida, in December.
- 4. The Staff discussed the upcoming state championships and festivals in competitive cheer, drill team, swimming, basketball, wrestling, speech and debate, theatre and music.
- 5. The Executive Committee discussed the Summer Moratorium adjustment for member schools. The dates for the moratorium are June 28-July 4. The application for adjustment must be made as an entire school.

  certification.
