Executive Committee Meeting Summary October 1, 2025

- 1. Chairman Craig Hammer called the meeting to order and reviewed the important dates found in the UHSAA Ready Reference Calendars (see www.uhsaa.org).
- 2. Mr. Rob Cuff reminded Committee members that region nominations for distinguished service awards and school nominations for the super fan award are due to the UHSAA by November 1, 2025.
- 3. Mr. Jeff Cluff reviewed the 2025-2026 calendar. Calendar information can be found on the UHSAA website.
- 4. Schools are encouraged to get involved with unified sports. The UHSAA has partnered with Special Olympics Utah to sanction soccer, basketball, swimming, and track and field as unified sports events for the current school year. Interested schools should contact the UHSAA.
- 5. The importance of coaches' certification and the responsibility of schools and districts to track the certification of coaches was emphasized.
- 6. Mr. Everett Kelepolo provided a UIAAA Report and discussed the NIAAA Conference in Tampa, Florida, this coming December.
- 7. The Executive Committee has again determined that adjustments for Summer Moratorium (June 29-July 5) can only be made as an entire school, not per sport or activity. Schools have been given an exception for participation in non-competition service activities such as a parade.
- 8. Sportsmanship items, including the video competition and the Gold Star Coach Award, were discussed.
- 9. Mr. Cluff provided an officials' update to the Committee.
- 10. Mr. Brenan Jackson discussed recommendations from the Boys Soccer Coaches Association for the upcoming season. Committee members were asked to discuss the proposal in region meetings.
- 11. Mr. Chris Shipman discussed academic all-state dates and deadlines.
- 12. Ms. Missy Mackay-Whiteurs discussed fall student leadership conferences and the Show up for Sports Service Initiative that has been sent to member schools.
- 13. Mr. Steve Marsing discussed items regarding the state swim championships.

- 14. The Executive Committee discussed UHSAA Moratoriums and were asked to discuss considerations in region meetings.
- 15. Mr. Cuff provided dates and a timeline for the establishment of the 2027-2029 realignment of member schools. Executive Committee members will discuss the realignment in region meetings in preparation for the November meeting.
