

Executive Committee Meeting Summary
March 18, 2026

1. Chairman Craig Hammer called the meeting to order and reviewed important dates found in the UHSAA Ready Reference Calendars (see www.uhsaa.org). Academic All-State deadlines were also discussed.
2. Mr. Rob Cuff provided the Committee with a list of winter state champions and the UHSAA staff reviewed winter activities, which included basketball, wrestling, drill team, cheer and swim.
3. Mr. Cuff and staff discussed the realignment of member schools for the school years 2027-2029. Recommendations were made by the Executive Committee and will be discussed with the Board of Trustees.
4. Mr. Jeff Cluff reviewed the winter ejection reports for coaches and players and provided an officiating update.
5. Mr. Everett Kelepolo, Executive Director of the UIAAA, reminded members that the UIAAA Conference for athletic administrators is April 15-18 in St. George.
6. Ms. Jan Whittaker reviewed UHSAA sportsmanship items and provided an update for Esports, which will conclude its first championship season in April.
7. The UHSAA Student Leadership Conferences will be held in the fall by region or on a multi-region basis.
8. Mr. Chris Shipman reported on the Unified Sports Tournament for basketball. The UHSAA and SOUT (Special Olympics Utah) are once again joining together to provide this outstanding experience for student athletes.
9. Ms. Missy Mackay-Whiteurs shared information regarding cheer safety clinics and softball.
10. Mr. Brenan Jackson discussed coaches' certification and approved soccer clubs for next level opportunities.
11. The Christmas Moratorium will be December 21-25. Schools may change the Christmas moratorium dates sport by sport as long as it is five days and includes Christmas and submitted to UHSAA.
12. The Summer Moratorium is June 29-July 5. Schools may change the summer moratorium dates, but the change must be done as an entire school and submitted to UHSAA.
