

Executive Committee Meeting Summary  
April 22, 2026

1. Chairman Craig Hammer called the meeting to order and reviewed important dates found in the UHSAA Ready Reference Calendars (see [www.uhsaa.org](http://www.uhsaa.org)).
2. The UHSAA staff reviewed speech/debate, Esports, theatre and music activities.
3. Mr. Jeff Cluff reviewed and discussed the 2026-2027 calendar ([www.uhsaa.org](http://www.uhsaa.org)). Dates and sites for next year's UHSAA activities have been approved by the Executive Committee. Refer to website for dates and sites.
4. Mr. Cluff discussed coaches' credentials and provided an officiating update.
5. Mr. Brenan Jackson discussed coaches' certification. He reminded members that head coaches and assistant coaches need to complete the certification prior to coaching. Districts and schools shoulder the responsibility of training coaches and complying with RegisterMyCoach for tracking those who have certified.
6. The Summer Moratorium is June 29-July 5. Schools may change the summer moratorium dates, but the change must be made as an entire school and submitted to UHSAA.
7. The Executive Committee reviewed the 3-day 1A basketball tournament from this past basketball season with positive results.
8. Ms. Jan Whittaker discussed the UHSAA sportsmanship initiative and encouraged all schools and regions to support the initiative by increasing the awareness of good sportsmanship. Forms will be available on the UHSAA website for schools to apply for their 2025-2026 sportsmanship star to include on their sportsmanship banner. Some schools will earn their 16<sup>th</sup> star this school year. The applications are due to UHSAA by May 26, 2026.
9. Ms. Missy Mackay-Whiteurs discussed the Student Leadership Conference, which will take place in the fall on a region level. Multiple regions can also join together to have the Conference. Sportsmanship representatives from each region will be trained by the UHSAA in preparation for the fall conferences.
10. Mr. Chris Shipman discussed Unified Sports and Academic All-State.
11. A Constitution and By-Laws Report was presented and discussed. Recommendations by the Executive Committee were forwarded to the Board of Trustees for further discussion at the May meeting.

12. Mr. Rob Cuff and the UHSAA staff discussed the realignment of member schools for the school years 2027-2029. Recommendations were made by the Executive Committee and will be discussed with the Board of Trustees.
13. Ms. Wendy Anae, UIAAA President, reported on the UIAAA Conference held recently in St. George. There were many training sessions, breakout sessions and workshops for participants.
14. In the March meeting, the Executive Committee approved the appointment of Principal David Cluff of Milford HS to be the 1A Principal representative for three years to the Board of Trustees.
